ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The level of the program to which the prospective student is admitted depends on the prior academic training of the student.

- 1. Applicants with a primary education are limited to the diploma level.
- 2. Applicants who have completed a secondary school program may study at the Associate level.
- 3. A pastoral or denominational recommendation is required for admission into the degree programs.

CURRICULUM PHILOSOPHY

Our curriculum philosophy is that any Christian leadership education begins with a solid understanding of the Bible and Christian doctrine. This provides the foundation on which is built solid, biblically based ministry skills such as preaching effectiveness, pastoral counseling, discipleship, outreach and Christian leadership.

CURRICULUM

Program completion requires a minimum of 16 classes. Each class consists of at least 16 hours of instruction. In our onsite programs these classes are offered in intensive format over a period of 2 days. Our online classes are more flexible with scheduling but will also have a minimum of 16 hours of class time.

The classes can be taken at one of the following levels:

Auditor - This program is for students who want to attend classes but are not interested in academic credit. (The number of auditors per class are limited)

Diploma in Pastoral Studies - Requires at least a primary school education but reading and writing along with homework will be necessary for course credit.

Associate of Pastoral studies - Requires completed secondary education and pastoral or denominational recommendations.
